The tutorial will introduce in the notion of question as a linguistic object, and as a move in communication. The following topics will be covered: Types of questions (polarity, constituent, alternative questions), occurrence of questions (as embedded clauses or root clauses), the semantic modelling of questions (as functional meanings, proposition sets, partitions or relations as in inquisitive semantics), and the nature of questions as speech acts.
