The position consists of 40 hours of monthly work starting from May 2020 and includes varying tasks. The tasks can include:

- experimental work (designing, carrying out, analyzing)
- organisation of and helping at conferences/workshops
- · corpus related work

We are particularly interested in students with the following qualifications:

- knowledge of linguistic theory on at least a bachelor's degree level in a relevant subject (e.g. general linguistics, German studies, etc.)
- background in experimental work
- · some background in corpus related work is appreciated
- good command of English (both written and orally; good command of German is appreciated, but not necessary)
- basic knowledge of statistics is appreciated (both theory and practical application, e.g. doing stats in R for analyzing experimental data)
- knowledge of R and Praat is highly appreciated

The application should include a short academic CV (at most 1 page, no picture, 1 inch or 2.5cm margins, 12pt) and a short motivational letter (at most 1 page, 1 inch or 2.5cm margins, 12pt, one-half spacing) highlighting your academic expertise relevant for the position.
